



Contract For RTC-TV Video Programming Service Lawrence County

This contract is entered into by _____ (Subscriber) and Daviess-Martin Rural Telephone Company dba RTC Communications (Provider) beginning on _____.

The Subscriber agrees to subscribe to the Provider's **Lawrence County Premium or Premium Plus** television video service, RTC-TV, for a period of twenty-four (24) consecutive months, without interruption, from the above date at a rate of either **\$66.19 (Premium Package Price) + \$9.25 (Local Network Fees) OR \$76.92(Premium Plus Package Price) + \$9.25 (Local Network Fees)** per month plus any applicable taxes or fees. *(Without this agreement, normal installation and set top box fees apply.)* **The subscriber shall also receive a \$25 bill credit for the Premium Package or a \$30 bill credit for the Premium Plus Package for the first twelve billing cycles as a one-year promotional rate.** In exchange, the Provider will supply the Subscriber with a DSL modem if needed. Additional fees will apply for each set top box and for any other additional services as requested by the subscriber. After paying for twenty-four (24) consecutive months of service, the DSL modem and set top box(es) become the property of the Subscriber. If the Subscriber fails, in any regard, to continue the RTC-TV service for twenty-four (24) consecutive months, the Provider will apply a charge of \$20 for each month of the contract term not fulfilled. If customer does not return the set top box(es) in good working order, a charge of \$172 per set top box, \$354 per digital video recorder set top box, \$145 for the DSL modem, and any applicable taxes and fees, plus the initial installation charge of \$95, will be applied to the Subscriber's monthly bill for payment of the Provider's set top box(es) and DSL modem. After the contract terms have been completed, customer may return the set top box(es), in good working order, and receive a credit of \$50 per set top box. A credit of \$20 will be given for the return of a good working modem.

The Provider does not warrant the DSL modem or set top box(es) for any defects except those covered under the original manufacturer's warranty. The Subscriber is solely responsible for the good working order of the DSL modem and set top box(es) and the protection of same from damage, including Acts of God i.e. lightning. The subscriber understands the Provider will not replace the DSL modem and/or set top box(es), without a fee, if they become damaged. Damage to the DSL modem, set top box(es), televisions, or other video equipment does not relieve the Subscriber from the liability of payment for video programming service.
